# Stripped Marlin





## LOCATION

**Bahia Magdalena is located in Baja California Sur. We will arrive to San Carlos a fishing village 3:30 hours by car from la Paz.**

San Carlos it's a small fishing community on the west coast of the Baja California Sur peninsula. Here we find the habitat of a lot of pelagic animals. Each year, from October to December, one of the most spectacular migrations of striped marlins happen right here. You can also expect whales, sea lions, turtles and more.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

# The Marlin Expedition lasts 6 days, which includes:

### ○ **4 whole days at sea**

With the probabilities of encounters with striped marlins, whales, sea lions, turtles and more.

### ● **5 nights at a hotel**

The stay is in a local hotel at San Carlos. Each room is a double room, AC and private restroom, wifi and hot water.

### ● **Food and non alcoholic beverages;** breakfast, snacks, lunch and dinner.

### ● **Open water activities**

and if weather and time permits a tour in the mangroves and sand dunes.

### ● **Local transportation included**

from La Paz to San Carlos.

## Not included:

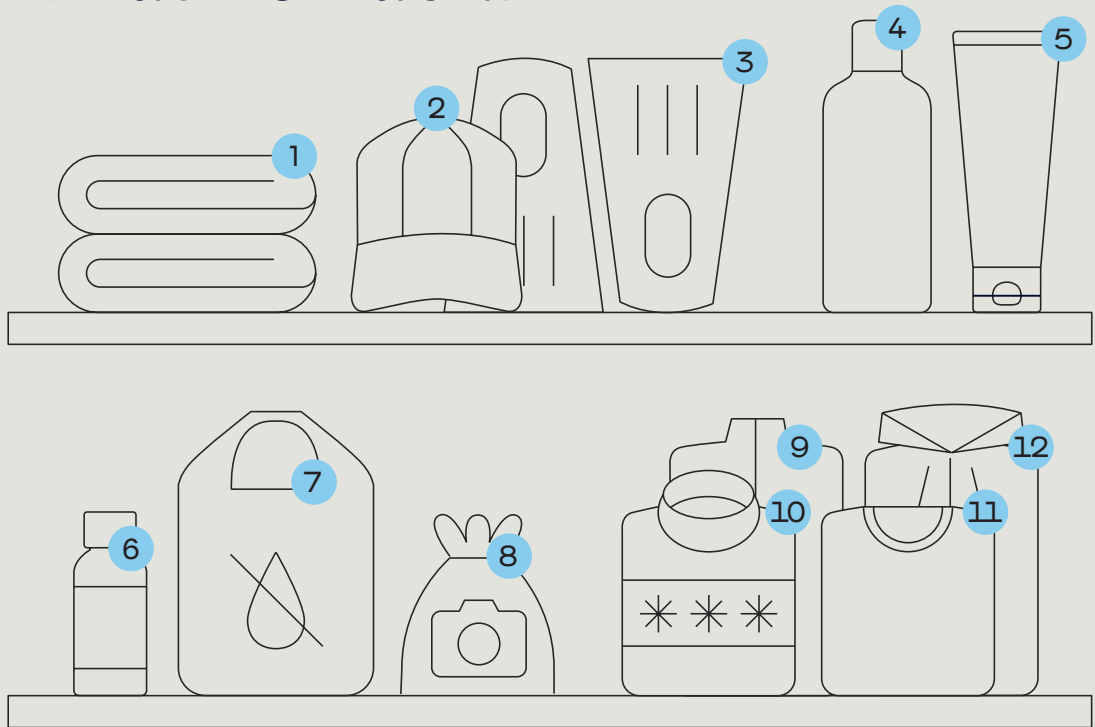
- × Airplane tickets.
- × Accomodation in la Paz or Los Cabos.
- × It is recommeded to arrive at La Paz a night before the expedition or the same day before 1:00pm. The start of the expedition will be at 3:00 pm from La Paz.
- × Alcoholic drinks are stricly prohibited during the time spent on the boat. You can only consume alcohol in San Carlos once the activity at sea is over.
- × Snorkel equipment is not included.

- × Because it is an snorkeling activity there is no need to be PADI certified.





# What To Pack:



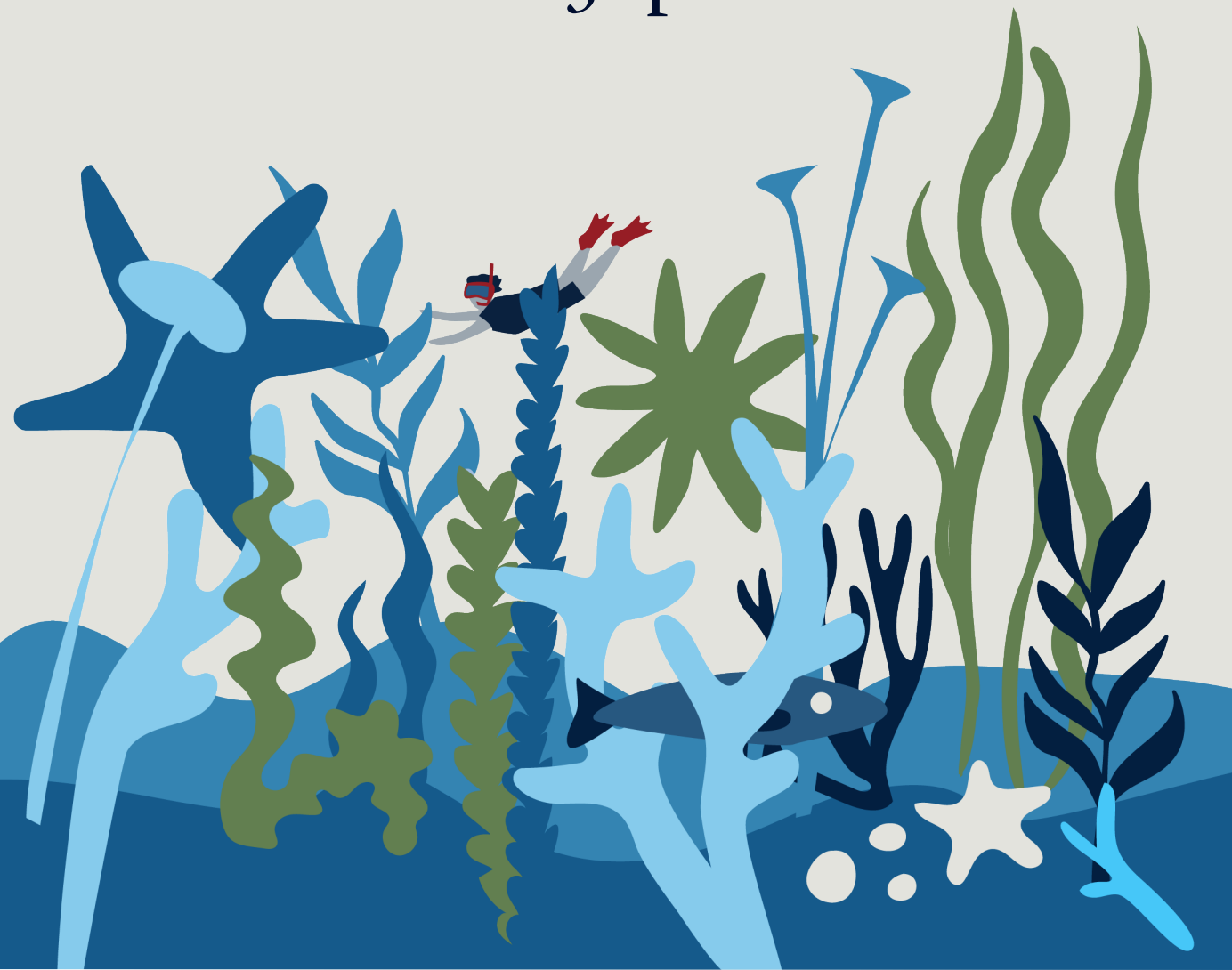
- 1 Towel (optional).

- 3 Snorkel Equipment (fins, mask & snorkel)
- 4 Bug Spray.
- 5 SPF.
- 6 Seasick medication.
- 7 Dry Bag.
- 8 Photographic gear
- 9 Wetsuit 3-5 mm.  
Windbreaker, sweater or hoodie.
- 10 Long sleeve shirt (protection from cold  
and sun).
- 11 and sun).
- 12 Raincoat.



## A TYPICAL DAY OF A MARLIN EXPEDITION

- Departure to the sea at 7:30 am, after having breakfast at a local restaurant.
- Depending on the conditions of the day, we will be looking for pelagic species and hopefully we will find: Stripped Marlin, Sea Lions, Turtles, and Whales.
- We will focus on locating sardine or mackarel baitball for snorkeling while the marlin eat.

- Lunch in the boat (Please let us know of any food restriction).
- Look for more pelagic life and finish off with mangroves and sand dunes.
- We get back to San Carlos around 6:45 pm to rest.
- Dinner at 8:30pm.

### How to get there

The closest airport is in La Paz, located 3:30hrs of San Carlos (Shuttle Included). If you are planning to arrive to Los Cabos, you should consider 3 more hours (Shuttle from Los Cabos to La Paz not included.)

# Requirements

- ① Basic knowledge of snorkeling.
- ② Liability waiver.
- ③ To be in good shape.
- ④ Tolerance to the sea (sun, waves, wind, and movement).

# Safety

Our profesional guide will give a saftey briefing at your arrival at San Carlos.

Swimming with pelagic species is a safe activity as long as the safety instructions and rules are respected. At all times you will be accompanied by a professional guide, who will ensure that you have an incredible experience!

# Release of obligations

**We do not assure any type of pelagic encounter.** We will do our best to see all kinds of marine animals, taking into account that there is the possibility of not having any encounters, after all, we are talking about the big blue.

## Meteorology

If the meteorological reports of the weather conditions do not allow a safe expedition (winds of 18-30 knots and waves of 3-4 meters) we will find ourselves in the painful need to **cancel** the expedition. This decision will be made 1 week before the trip. In case of cancellation, a change of date or a **full refund** of your deposit will be made. In case the **cancellation** occurs in San Carlos, please consult our policies.

# Cancellation Policy

- **The reservation will be considered confirmed** once the deposit of 50% of the total quoted is received, in addition to sending you completed registration form. no trip is considered booked or confirmed without these requirements.
- **In case of cancellation by the traveler,** the deposit will not be refunded.
- **The deposit may remain as a guarantee** for the next 6 months after the cancellation of the trip, however it will not be refunded nor may it be transmitted to third parties.
- **In the extraordinary case that the company cancels the trip,** the total deposit will be refunded to the traveler.
